## FINANCIAL AID FOR STUDY ABROAD - TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### Applying for Financial Aid

You must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the academic year in which you are planning to study abroad in order to be eligible to receive any financial aid awards. You can apply online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). If you have not had financial aid previous to this academic year or you do not currently have financial aid in this academic year, please see the "How to Apply" tab online at <https://www.uhd.edu/financial/Pages/financial-index-2.aspx>

Once you have completed the FAFSA and if you are chosen for verification as noted on your Student Aid Report, you can view these requirements via the financial aid portal or contact our office for required documents. This process can take up to 3 weeks or more to be completed, so plan in advance.

If you are required to turn in the "Satisfactory Academic Progress Appeal Form", please turn this in with any supporting documentation as soon as possible.

Be sure to monitor your requirement online via the financial aid portal to see if any additional documentation is needed to determine your aid eligibility.

### Using Financial Aid to Study Abroad

You must be enrolled at UHD in a degree-seeking program and participating in a University-approved study abroad program, enrolled at least half-time, and making Satisfactory Academic Progress as defined by the University and by the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid.

You may not postpone your graduation in order to study abroad and receive financial aid. In these cases, participation must be at your own expense.

**There is no guarantee that you will receive enough financial aid to completely cover the total cost of the study abroad program.**

You will need to pay all required deposits for your study abroad program, since financial aid funds are generally not available on your student account until ten days before your classes for study abroad begin.

### Receiving your Financial Aid

Financial aid for studying abroad, as with all other enrollment periods, cannot be authorized for disbursement to your student account until approximately 10 days prior to the start of your study abroad classes.

It is recommended that you are sure of your refund preference as funds will be delivered to you based on the method chosen. You can check out your refund preferences at <https://www.uhd.edu/student-resources/cashiers/Pages/higherone-refund.aspx>

**IF ANY INFORMATION CHANGES (i.e. dates, credit hours, or anything else about the program) the student is required to notify the Office of Student Financial Aid. Your eligibility may then need to be recalculated.**
