Rockwell Fund, Inc. has established a drama scholarship to reward deserving students who actively participate in the University of Houston-Downtown's theatre program.

GUIDELINES

The recipient(s) of this scholarship must:

1. Have a 3.0 overall G.P.A.
2. Be enrolled and remain enrolled for at least 6 hours of coursework in the semester that the scholarship is awarded.
3. Be willing and able to become involved in some way with the play(s) being presented during the semester that the scholarship is awarded.
4. Be available as needed to assist with various theatre tasks and projects.
5. Display a positive, willing, respectful and professional attitude at all times.
6. Write the required essay outlined on the back of this application.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Monies for this scholarship will become available upon the announcement of the recipients' names.
2. Scholarship monies can only be used for educational purposes. This includes, but is not limited to: UHD tuition, books and fees; classroom materials; participation in drama trips; the furthering of one's professional and/or educational theatre preparation through auditioning, acting training, workshop participation, conference attendance and the like; and acquiring printed or video materials for one's personal library and study resources.
3. The recipient(s) of this scholarship will be determined by the Drama Scholarship Committee consisting of the Director of Theatre, the Technical Director and one additional drama instructor. This committee will also decide on interpretations of and exceptions to the scholarship guidelines and application process.
4. If for some reason a scholarship recipient is unwilling or unable to complete the responsibilities assigned during the semester, steps will be taken to have the awarded monies returned in full or part.

Application Deadline: as indicated in the current University Theatre Production and Activities Schedule. (Check the UH-D web site for this schedule, or pick one up in the theatre lobby, or outside 1057-S.)
