General Information

Eight to ten Stokes scholarships are available each semester. Students interested in being considered for one need to apply by the end of the second week of school in the semester which they are applying. It is then up to the student to meet the scholarship's criteria during that semester. At the end of that semester, a list of the applicants who have successfully met the criteria will be posted. They will be determined by a panel of judges consisting of the director of theatre, the technical theatre director and one additional UHD faculty member.

The following criteria will be used to determine the successful applicants:

1. The amount and quality of completed service the applicant has performed for the drama program during the semester.
2. The applicant's display of a positive, willing, respectful and professional attitude.
3. The applicant's overall GPA which must be 2.0 and Drama GPA which must be 2.25.

Stokes scholarship monies can only be used for things that are educational in nature. Such things include, but are not limited to: UHD tuition, books and fees; participation in the New York and London drama trips; furthering one's professional and/or educational theatre preparation through auditioning, additional acting training, workshop participation, conference attendance and the like; and acquiring printed or video materials for one's personal library and study resources. *All scholarship monies must be used within six (6) months of being awarded.*

There is a final responsibility to write a report for Ms. George Ann Stokes, Trustee of the Stokes Foundation, describing the activity or activities that the applicant has undertaken. This report must be turned in as soon as the activity has been completed. No additional scholarship can be awarded until this report is submitted.

Candidate application forms are due to Dr. Thomas J. Lyttle, S-1057, (713) 221- 8118, by no later than the end of the second week of school.
