



Lone Star College Student Joint Admission Contract with University of Houston-Downtown

The parties to this agreement are _____(student)
_____(SSN), and the University of Houston-Downtown (UHD).

Student has been admitted to UHD for the _____ semester under the Joint Admission Agreement in entered into November 12, 2002 between Lone Star College System (LSCS) and UHD.

To be eligible for Joint Admission, the student must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Be currently enrolled at Lone Star College System (LSCS)**
- 2. Meet UHD's admission requirements**
- 3. Be Texas Success Initiative complete**
- 4. Not be a former UHD student or an international student**

As a joint admission student, student is entitled to receive the following services from UHD:

1. Library privileges, including online database access
2. Access to UHD computer labs
3. UHD Student ID
4. Advising Services
5. E-services access
6. UHD GatorMail e-mail account

The following conditions apply:

1. The student's enrollment at UHD is governed by the terms and provisions of the UHD Catalog in effect at the time of admission.
2. In no event can student graduate under a UHD catalog more than 10 years old.
3. Student must maintain continuous enrollment for this agreement to remain in effect. If a student fails to enroll at either LSCS or UHD for two long semesters, then student will be required to reapply and will be subject to the UHD Catalog in force at the time of reapplication.
4. Student will be eligible to apply for acceptance to one of the UHD degree granting colleges and/or to declare a major, upon meeting the stated requirements as if student was currently enrolled at UHD.
5. Student understands that credit for courses taught at the lower division at LSCS will not be accepted in fulfillment of course requirements taught at the upper division at UHD except in limited circumstances provided in specific program articulation agreements.

6. Student declares to be covered by a specific program articulation agreement by completing the Individual Articulation Agreement.
7. Student will be considered “home” to LSCS for financial aid purposes as long as student is enrolled in lower division courses at LSCS. If student takes courses from UHD, then the student will become “home” to UHD and required to comply with UHD financial aid requirements.
8. Student understands that to utilize certain library and athletic facilities at UHD, a UHD student ID is required which must be obtained in person from UHD at One Main Street during normal business hours.
9. Student will comply with all LSCS and UHD advising requirements.
10. Student will activate GatorMail e-mail account to receive communications from UHD about programs and status and will regularly monitor it for communications from UHD. Student acknowledges that communications sent by UHD to the student’s GatorMail account are official notice from the university.
11. Student is subject to the academic and disciplinary policies of the enrolling institution(s). Additionally student is subject to policies governing student use of computers, technology, e-mail, athletic facilities and library when using those services, without regard to enrollment.
12. Student will be eligible to register for courses at UHD as though they were previously registered full-time at UHD.
13. Student understands that loss of eligibility to continue in classes at either institution may cause termination of this agreement.
14. Student may cancel this agreement at any time upon written notice to the UHD Office of Enrollment Services and to the Admissions Office at the student’s LSCS college.

By signing this agreement, the student authorizes UHD and LSCS to exchange all information on a regular basis related to the student’s enrollment at either institution for purposes of maintaining academic, discipline and other appropriate student records as required to be maintained by each institution, and certifies that he/she meets Joint Admission requirements as outlined above.
