

Writing Proficiency Exam (WPE)

If you have completed 60 or more college-level credit hours, are seeking a degree from UHD and have not passed the Writing Proficiency Examination (WPE), you must register to take the exam. For WPE dates and registration information, and exam results visit Testing Services web site www.uhd.edu/admissions/testing.htm. Students must bring in their student IDs when they wish to register. Information on the criteria used to evaluate essays may be found in the UHD catalog.

Register for their Writing Proficiency Exam (WPE) online. Each test session will cost \$10.00 and the fees are non-refundable and non-transferable. Students must register for one testing session at a time. Once students have taken the WPE, the exam must be scored before registering again.

To handle the WPE registration and payment, students should log onto www.uhd.edu, select student e-services, and then My Payment option. At the My Payment menu, click on the "Testing Payment" and follow the online instructions to choose and pay for the available test date and location.

Once the online transaction has been processed, students must print their online admission ticket/receipt and bring it to the scheduled testing location at least 15 minutes before the reposting time.

Bring current UHD ID or non-expired government issued photo ID, Admission ticket/receipt, Writing instruments, Paper dictionary/thesaurus (optional), Hand-outs from the Writing Center(optional) Room N925. All types of electronic devices are prohibited on day of exam.
