Students with permits may also park in the Shea Street parking lot located at Shea and North Main, and/or Naylor Street parking lot located at Naylor and North Main, and/or the Washington Street parking lot located between Milam and Louisiana Streets.

Disabled Parking Permits

Parking areas with easy access to the building are designated for disabled students: both permanent and temporary permits are available. For information, contact the Parking Office at 713/221-8127.

Two-Wheel Permits

Covered parking for two-wheel vehicles is entered from Girard Street. The cost is \$4.00 for each summer session and \$7.00 for a fall or spring semester.

UH System Universities Permits

A student with a valid parking permit issued by UH, UH-Clear Lake, and UH-Victoria may park in any designated student area lot.

Other parking

City parking meters and private parking facilities are located within easy walking distance of the university. Maps are located in the Parking Office.

Parking Refunds

Parking fees are refunded according to the same schedule for tuition and fees. Please see the Academic Calendar at the beginning of this class schedule for dates and amounts.

Lockers

Student lockers are available on a first-come, first-served basis for a cost of \$15 per semester. You may request a locker in Student Activities, S204.

Everything Else You Need To Know

UHD Catalog

As a UHD student **you are responsible for obtaining a copy of the UHD Catalog** from the Information Office or familiarizing yourself with the online document. Academic policies and practices, course descriptions, degree plans and other important information are found in the UHD Catalog.

UHD Student Handbook

It is your responsibility to obtain a copy of the UHD Student Handbook from the Information Office or to familiarize yourself with the online document. Important student policies, rights and responsibilities are outlined in the UHD Student Handbook.

Course Load

A regular undergraduate course load during the fall and spring terms is 15 to 16 semester credit hours or five courses. To be considered a full-time student, you must be enrolled in 12 semester credit hours. For students who are employed 40 hours per week, the recommended load is two courses, or six credit hours, which is considered half-time enrollment. The regular load for one summer session or a minimester is six to eight credit hours. Students who wish to enroll in 20 credit hours or more in a long semester or nine hours or more in a summer session must receive approval from the appropriate academic dean. For information on graduate course load consult specific master's degree handbooks.

Auditing classes

If you wish to audit a class, you must follow all enrollment procedures, including payment. With the approval of the instructor, you may request that a course be changed to audit status prior to the Official Day of Record for the appropriate term.

A **Request to Audit** form may be obtained from the Registrar's Office. Senior citizens 65 years of age and over may audit classes for free on a space-available basis. For more information on auditing a class, consult the UH-Downtown Catalog or contact the Registrar's Office, 713/221-8999.
