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Beginning Fall 2016, UHD implemented a policy that allows new students to declare their major upon admission to the University, if eligible. This results in a larger number of new students declaring majors than in previous years. This change is partially responsible for the increase in undergraduate majors (and decrease in undeclared majors) throughout the university.

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The Security Management program has moved to the College of Business effective Fall 2014. To allow easier comparison across time the prior years' information is also listed with the current college.

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


SUMMER SEMESTER 2018 Fact Sheet Data Based on Certified State Reports


Headcount by Year and Student Type



Semester Credit Hours by Year and Student Type





Overall Gender Distribution


