



All faculty, staff, and students who park vehicles on UHD property must register their vehicles through the Parking Office and display a valid parking permit.

A parking permit signifies an individual has been granted the privilege of parking on university property. Ownership of the permit remains with the University. The permit is only transferable between vehicles and NOT between individuals. The registered permit holder is responsible for any parking citation issued to a vehicle displaying their parking permit.

Faculty, staff, students and visitors must comply with UHD rules and regulations for traffic and parking, as outlined in PS 01.B.02.

To help garage permit holders visualize the area where they can park, columns have been color-coded to assist with assigned parking.

- **Blue** Columns – Academic Bldg. Garage (P1 & P2) will be for unreserved parking for Staff and Faculty all hours, all days. However, Faculty should not park on P2 unless the faculty area on P3 Girard Street bldg. garage is full.

- **Red** Columns – Academic Bldg. Garage (P3) Reserved Parking Permit required, Monday – Friday, 7:00am – 5:00pm.

- **Green** Columns – Girard Street Bldg. Garage-P3 (through second set of gates) unreserved parking for Faculty, Monday – Thursday 8:00am – 5:00pm.

Green Columns – Girard Street Garage Bldg-P3 (through second set of gates) **Friday only**, Staff may park in the interior rows only. Faculty-only parking is identified with posted signage.

Garage overflow parking is available in the Shea Street Bldg. & Vine Street garages; gated lots - Wood St. & Washington St. and parking lots Daly Street, A and B.

General/Surface lot parking permits locations are Lot A, Daly St., Bayou Lot, and Washington St. Access into the Academic Bldg. garage will be granted at 5:00pm, Monday – Friday and all day on weekends.

A Faculty or Staff permit will not provide access into the Visitors' Parking Garage.

Disabled parking privileges are for the benefit of the registered permit holder only. The university requires that a university disabled parking permit be displayed along with a valid state-issued disabled parking placard or state license plate when parked in any disabled parking space on campus.

Motorcycles must be registered under the same conditions as vehicles and are subject to the same regulations as vehicles. Motorcycles spaces are available in the Visitors' Parking and Naylor Street garages.

UHD is not responsible or liable for any damage to and/or theft of any vehicle, its equipment or content while the vehicle is parked on university owned property.
