\*\*\*Additional requirements for Master's Program Applicants.

Students applying for the scholarship for the MSCJ program at UHD must meet the following minimum qualifications and subsequently be accepted to the MSCJ program.

1. Completion of a baccalaureate degree in criminal justice or related field from an accredited university. Applicants without a bachelor's degree in criminal justice may be required to complete additional preparatory course work as a condition of admission to the program.
2. A grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.0 for the last 60 semester hours of undergraduate or graduate study.
3. Applicants whose baccalaureate degree was conferred by a university whose native language is not English must demonstrate English proficiency with a minimum composite score of 550 on the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) exam as well as a minimal score of 50 on each of the subscales.

4. Three letters of recommendation signed from individuals acquainted with the applicant's potential for academic success. Students who have graduated within the previous 5 years, need two of the recommendation letters to come from a former professor
