

Appeal of the Admissions Decision

Students with a conditional admission or who are denied admission and have additional, new information that may help inform the Admissions Committee's decision may appeal the decision. Appeals must be made in writing and postmarked within 20 days from the date of the admission's status letter. Within 20 days of the receipt of the student's appeal, the review will be completed by the Admissions Committee.

The Review Committee will issue a decision in writing within one week of the reconsideration. If the student has evidence that the Review Committee has made its decision in violation of the program's policies, the student may appeal the Committee's decision in the following sequence:

- To the Department Chair
- To the Dean of the College of Public Service. (This policy is informed by PS 03.A.04 for Grade Appeals.)
