The MAT degree program requires completion of a minimum of 36 semester credit hours. For degree completion, at least 30 hours must be completed at UH-Downtown with a grade point average of 3.0. In addition, students must successfully complete a directed studies project (MAT 6390) with approval of the MAT in Early Childhood Studies mentor and under the supervision of an appointed faculty advisor. This master's degree does not include initial Texas Teacher Certification.
