*For the Preparatory Requirements section, students must complete 18 hours (6 courses) of interdisciplinary coursework beyond the Core. Students are encouraged to spread the 18 hours evenly among the areas of Art & Humanities, Social Sciences, and Math/Science or CS, but may opt to concentrate hours in any of the areas once each has been satisfied with 1 course. For example, a student can fulfill the Prep area with 4 Spanish courses, an Economics, and a Geology course; or with 1 English course, 3 Psychology courses, and 2 Biology courses.

Note that the BS-IS degree may be completed without a Minor. However, UHD offers over 50 Minor programs—consult with your academic advisor to discuss minors that complement your career goals and customize your degree plan accordingly.

Students who are limited to a specific format, such as in-person only or online only, may be dependent upon course availability and are urged to register as soon as possible to secure the classes/times/formats they need.
