### **Using the Chat and Virtual Classrooms**

Virtual Classroom and Chat are collaboration tools which allow you to communicate in real-time with other class members.

#### **Accessing the Tools**

1. In the left-hand course menu, look for a Tools link.

**Note:** Your professor may have also made Chat or Virtual Classroom available in another content area. Be sure to follow your professor's instructions.




2. Locate and click **Collaboration** from the list of available tools.



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
3. You will see one or more sessions. Click the title of the session you would like to join.



#### Chat

Chat allows users to interact with each other and the Instructor via a text-based chat region. This region is part of the Virtual Classroom, but can also be accessed separately without the rest of the tools that make up the Virtual Classroom.

- A. Chat area
- B. Compose and send messages
- C. Participants list



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#### Virtual Classroom

The Virtual Classroom works similarly to the Chat tool, however there are more features found in the virtual classroom. Users can ask question, draw on a whiteboard, and participate in breakout sessions.

- A. Chat area
- B. Whiteboard for sharing drawings and text
- C. Participants list
- D. Set of tools for use with the whiteboard
- E. Clickable menu of additional tools
- F. Toolbar for recording and saving Virtual Class session recordings
