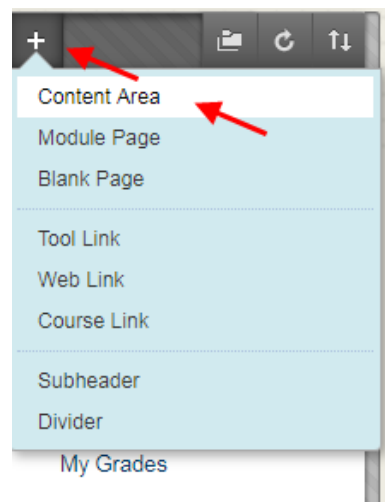


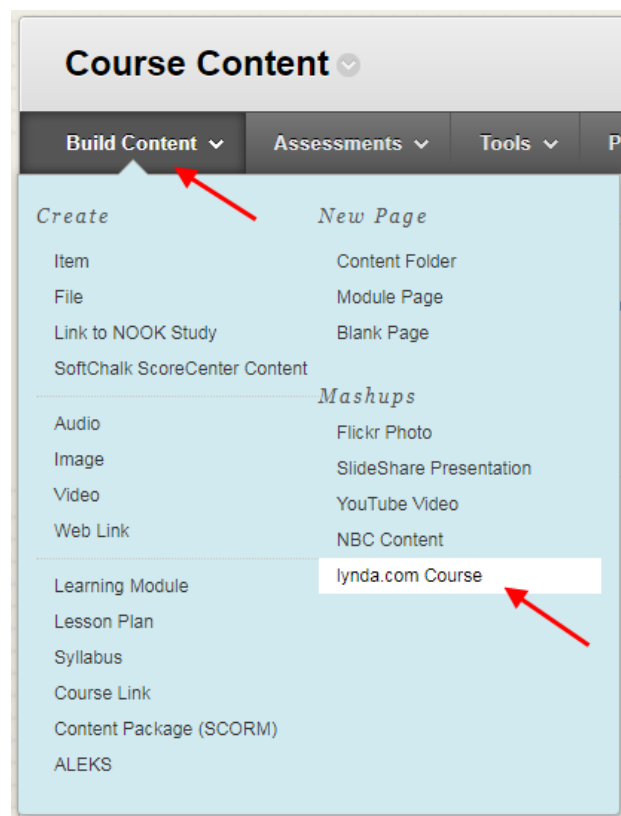
Adding Lynda.com Lessons in Blackboard

Lynda.com is a library of training videos covering many different subjects. These lessons can now easily be linked into Blackboard using the method described here.

1. Access the Content Area where you would like to place the link to the Lynda.com lesson.
 - (Optional) Use the '+' at the top of the course menu to create a new Content Area, if desired.



2. From the **Build Content** menu, select lynda.com Course.



3. **Search** the Lynda.com catalogue for lessons.
 - Most lessons are more professional than academic, but you may find something that correlates well with your subject.
4. Click the **+Add** button below a lesson's description to add it to your Blackboard course.

Viewing Lynda.com Lessons

Clicking on the Blackboard link will take your students to Lynda.com. On the left is a list of the course contents, allowing students to select which lesson to play. Next to the contents tab is a Notebook tab.

Writing a note in the Notebook automatically saves a timestamp for the video playing at the time the note was entered. This lets students pause the video at a certain point, type a relevant note, and the note will be saved along with a thumbnail that when clicked will play the video from that point.

Students also have a set of tabs for **Overview**, **Transcript**, **View Offline**, and **Exercise Files**. See below for details.



Overview Transcript View Offline Exercise Files

- **Overview** Summarizes the lesson plan, including a list of topics included. Provides author's name and lists total viewing time for all lessons.
- **Transcript** Provides a transcript for the lesson currently viewed.
- **View Offline** Allows students to download the lesson and view from offline.
- **Exercise Files** Downloadable exercise files (PDF) that students can complete. Some library items do not include Exercise Files.
