When accessing the 'Videos' module, you will see all the videos posted within your portal as well as any being shared down by the umbrella. The most recently posted videos will appear at the top of the list. Unlike photos and files, videos cannot be uploaded directly to GatorSync. They must first be uploaded to a third-party video site and then added to GatorSync. To do this, click 'Add a Video' in the top right of the 'Videos' module.

On the resulting page, enter a name for the video and provide its URL after you have uploaded it to another site. Currently, GatorSync supports videos hosted by YouTube, Vimeo, or Facebook. After inputting these required fields, enter a description (optional) and decide whom it should be made available to.
