THREAT/RISK LEVEL	BEHAVIOR	ACTION
HIGH	Direct and specific threats that impose an imminent danger to the safety of self or others	
	Active killer	Call UHD Police at 713-221-8911 or 911 immediately.
	Attack/physical confrontation	Call UHD Police at 713-221-8911 or 911 immediately. Complete a Student Conduct Incident Report Form.
	<u>Direct</u> statements of harm to self or others (verbal or written)	Call UHD Police at 713-221-8911 or 911 immediately. Complete a Student Conduct Incident Report Form.
	Displays a weapon	Call UHD Police at 713-221-8911 or 911 immediately. Complete a Student Conduct Incident Report Form.
	Suicidal ideation/attempt	Call UHD Police at 713-221-8911 or 911 immediately. Complete a Behavior Intervention Team Report.
MODERATE	Significant or repeated disruption; signs of significant distress; no direct threat of harm present	
	Disruptive, verbally abusive behavior	Address the behavior directly with the student. If it continues, submit a Student Conduct Incident Report Form. Direct all questions to the Dean of Students Office at uhdstudentaffairs@uhd.edu.
	Statements of delusion or hallucinations	Submit a <u>Behavior Intervention</u> <u>Team Form</u> . Direct all questions to the Dean of Students Office at <u>uhdstudentaffairs@uhd.edu</u> .
	Harassment	Submit a <u>Discrimination and</u> <u>Harassment Report</u> . Direct all questions to the Title IX/Equity and Diversity Office at <u>titleix@uhd.edu</u> .
