

Basic Peace Officer Program Technical Credit

The University of Houston-Downtown (UHD) awards technical credit toward the Bachelor of Applied Arts and Sciences (BAAS) in Criminal Justice to students who successfully graduate from a Law Enforcement Academy, including UHD's own Basic Peace Officer program, or to students who hold TCOLE licensure. UHD will award a total of 20 credit hours applicable in the AAS Degree/ACE Equivalency/Technical Credit area of the BAAS in CJ degree plan.

- Submit a copy of the Academy certificate (or TCOLE license, if applicable) together with this form
- Students will receive transfer credit for the UHD equivalent courses CJLE 1501, 1502, 1503, and 1504
- These credits are not applicable toward any other degree program at UHD
- Students who have been awarded credit for the 4 Basic Peace Officer courses by another institution should not fill out this form; transfer credit will be awarded once UHD receives and articulates the appropriate transcript
