- creating a study plan, in addition to your coursework, is important for success
- each certification exam currently is \$116 (STR, ELAR 7-12 and Special Ed Specialist are \$136) check Pearson website to verify exam cost
- remediation is required after any unsuccessful testing attempt. If you have an unsuccessful attempt, you will meet with the Certification Officer to create your personalized remediation plan. If required, you have up to 5 attempts to pass each exam cabs rev. 8/2021
