- (1) EDUC 1300 is required for First Time in College (FTIC) students only. If not FTIC, take SPCH. FTIC students must still complete SPCH course.
- (2) Student will need 9-15 hours of Free Electives, depending on concentration or minor; SOCI 2336 and/or CRIJ 1310 could satisfy part of these hours.
- (3) Student will need 21 hours of Upper Level (UL) Criminal Justice Electives: Choose six courses from CJ 3302, CJ 3303, CJ 3305, CJ 3306, CJ 3307, CJ 3308, CJ 3309, CJ 3312, CJ 3313, CJ 3316, CJ 3317, CJ 3318, CJ 3319, CJ 4301, CJ 4302, CJ 4303, CJ 4304, CJ 4305, CJ 4306, CJ 4307, CJ 4309, CJ 4311, CJ 4312, CJ 4313, CJ 4314,
- CJ 4380, CJ 4390 or other UL CJ Electives Available (Note: CRIJ 1310 may be similar in content to CJ 3304 which is why it is not included in this list).
- (4) Student will need 12 hours for a Supplemental Concentration (1 Lower Level (LL) course and at least 3 UL courses) or 15-18 hours for a Minor.
