Notes/Comments (AAS in Law Enforcement to BAAS in Criminal Justice at UHD):

- (1) Credit awarded only after confirmation of TCOLE licensure or successful graduation from a Law Enforcement Academy (Prior Learning Assessment).
- (2) Student will need 12 hours of upper level courses (free electives); based on military experience, students may apply up to 12 hours of American Council of Education (ACE) credits to satisfy free electives.
- (3) Student will need 18 hours of Prescribed Electives; Choose six courses from CJ 3300, CJ 3302, CJ 3304, CJ 3305, CJ 3306, CJ 3307, CJ 3308, CJ 3309, CJ 3312, CJ 3313, CJ 3316, CJ 3317, CJ 3318, CJ 3319, CJ 3320, CJ 4301, CJ 4302, CJ 4303, CJ 4304, CJ 4305, CJ 4306, CJ 4309, CJ 4311, CJ 4313, CJ 4314, OR CJ 4390

<u>Articulation Agreement Information – Standard and Program to Program (P2P)</u>

Transfer of Credit & Student Benefits

- Credits from HCC that are transferrable to UHD degree programs may be specified in any program-to-program articulation agreement.
- Reverse transfer
- HCC students will be allowed access to academic advising services at UHD
- HCC Honors students admitted to UHD will receive:
 - Acceptance to UHD Honors Program with a minimum GPA (GPA varies by the College in which the program resides)
 - UHD will accept a minimum of 12 hours of transfer Honors credit; eligible for merit and need-based aid commensurate with qualifications
