Notes/Comments:

- (1) EDUC 1300 is required for First Time in College (FTIC) students only. If not FTIC, take COSC 1301. Students who are FTIC are still required to complete COSC 1301
- (2) Free electives (lower level or upper level) must be taken to complete the minimum 120 hours required for degree completion at UHD. EDUC 1300, COSC 1301, SPCH 1318, PSYC 2301, SPCH Elective, and ENGL Elective will count toward the free elective requirements.
- (3) COMM 1307 is required for completion of the program at UHD (not required for LSC Associate degree).

<u>Articulation Agreement Information – Standard and Program to Program (P2P)</u>

Transfer of Credit & Student Benefits

- Credits from LSC that are transferrable to UHD degree programs may be specified in any program-to-program articulation agreement.
- · Reverse transfer
- LSC students will be allowed access to academic advising services at UHD
- LSC Honors students admitted to UHD will receive:
 - Acceptance to UHD Honors Program with a minimum GPA (GPA varies by the College in which the program resides)
 - UHD will accept a minimum of 12 hours of transfer Honors credit; eligible for merit and need-based aid commensurate with qualifications
