Notes/Comments:

- (1) EDUC 1300 is required for First Time in College (FTIC) students only. If not FTIC, take SPCH 1311. FTIC students are still required to complete SPCH 1311.
- (2) Students must take (2) Literature courses. Literature will satisfy Lang. Phil., & Culture core as well as 1 required literature. One course must be pre-1800 and one course must be post-1800.
- (3) Students must take Beginning I course and Beginning II course of the same language: ARAB, CHIN, FREN, GERM, ITAL, JAPN, SGNL, SPAN
- (4) Select from Pre-1800 Literature: ENG 3307, 3322, 3337, 3347, 3352, 3358, 3362, or 3385.
- 5) Select from advanced literature: ENG 4311, 4312, 4313, 4314, 4324, 4327, 4330, 4341, 4350, 4390; HUM 4350.
- (6) Free electives (lower level or upper level) must be taken to complete the minimum 120 hours required for the BSW degree at UHD; Students should consult with an advisor to select free electives at UHD and/or select a minor field of study; EDUC 1300 (if FTIC) will count toward the free elective requirements.

Transfer of Credit & Student Benefits

- Credits from LSC that are transferrable to UHD degree programs may be specified in any program-to-program articulation agreement.
- · Reverse transfer
- LSC students will be allowed access to academic advising services at UHD
- LSC Honors students admitted to UHD will receive:
 - Acceptance to UHD Honors Program with a minimum GPA (GPA varies by the College in which the program resides)
 - UHD will accept a minimum of 12 hours of transfer Honors credit; eligible for merit and need-based aid commensurate with qualifications
