- EDUC 1300 is required for First Time in College (FTIC) students only.
- Waiver will be applied for students that have taken SOCW 2361 and/or SOCW 2362 at Lone Star College-Tomball or Lone Star College-Creekside Center.
- Life & Phys. Science options are: BIOL 1406, 1407, 1408, 2406, 2420, 2421, CHEM 1405, 1411, 1412, 2423, 2425, GEOL 1403, 1404, 1405, PHYS 1401, 1402, 1403, 1404, 1410, 2425, or 2426
- Language, Phil., Culture Component Area option must be fulfilled with English literature course (ENGL 2322, 2323, 2327, 2328, 2332, 2333, 2341, 2342, 2343, 2351)
- Free electives (lower level or upper level) must be taken to complete the minimum 120 hours required for the BSW degree at UHD; EDUC 1300 (if FTIC) and SPCH 1318 will count toward the free elective requirements.
- Creative Arts options are: ARTS 1301, 1303, 1304, MUSI 1306, 1309, DRAM 1310, or DANC 2303

## Articulation Agreement Information – Standard and Program to Program (P2P)

### Transfer of Credit & Student Benefits

- Credits from LSC that are transferrable to UHD degree programs may be specified in any program-to-program articulation agreement.
- Reverse transfer
- LSC students will be allowed access to academic advising services at UHD
- LSC Honors students admitted to UHD will receive:
  - Acceptance to UHD Honors Program with a minimum GPA (GPA varies by the College in which the program resides)
  - UHD will accept a minimum of 12 hours of transfer Honors credit; eligible for merit and need-based aid commensurate with qualifications

### Optional Partnership

- [Joint Admission](#) provides students the opportunity to maximize utilization of facilities and programs offered jointly by LSC and UHD:
  - Student ID at LSC and UHD
  - Student computer/internet account, access to computer labs and access to libraries at LSC and UHD
  - Student access to sporting events at UHD
  - Free electronic transfer transcript transmission/evaluation
  - Application fees will be waived for LSC students who apply to UHD within 6 months of earning an Associate's degree.
- Cooperative Advising allows students to access embedded advisors at both institutions for students who are:
  - Admitted (either through regular or joint admissions) at UHD
  - All LSC students with an expressed interest in transferring to UHD
  - Advising for all degree programs at UHD
- Employee discount provides LSC employees an opportunity to apply discounts or waive fees at UHD:
  - Application fee will be waived for LSC employees
  - Recognize the eligibility of LSC employees to apply for scholarship programs.

## **Standard Agreement & P2P Agreement**

(Associate of Arts to Bachelor of Social Work)

### Program Admission Requirements

- Admission to the Social Work Program is a competitive process.
- Students must submit a completed application packet including application form, two references on forms, required essays and transcripts of prior collegiate work.
- Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 in most recent 30 hours.

- UHD will calculate the higher grade received if a course is taken more than once for GPA requirements.
- UHD will accept a "D" in 1000/2000 level courses other than those listed under Program Specific Requirements.

### Program Specific Requirements

- Student must have earned a "C" or better in SOCW 2361, SOCW 2362 and Human Biology courses (BIOL 1406, 1407, 1408, and 1409).
- LSC will ensure the course syllabi for SOCW 2361 and SOCW 2362 include the designated CSWE competencies and the instructor teaching these courses possesses a MSW degree from a CSWE accredited institution and 2 years of professional practice experience.
