Notes/Comments:

- (1) EDUC 1300 is required for First Time in College (FTIC) students only.
- (2) Many Workforce Programs (AAS degrees) at LSC require at least 15 hours of general education (core curriculum courses) to complete degree requirements. Students will also need to satisfy additional core curriculum requirements to become "core complete" to earn the Bachelor of Applied Arts and Sciences in Applied Administration at UHD. Student may be able to complete additional core courses at Lone Star College prior to transferring to UHD or during summer semesters. Students are strongly encouraged to consult with an advisor at UHD regarding maximum transferrable credit hours.

<u>Articulation Agreement Information – Standard and Program to Program (P2P)</u>

Transfer of Credit & Student Benefits

- Credits from LSC that are transferrable to UHD degree programs may be specified in any program-to-program articulation agreement.
- · Reverse transfer
- LSC students will be allowed access to academic advising services at UHD
- LSC Honors students admitted to UHD will receive:
 - Acceptance to UHD Honors Program with a minimum GPA (GPA varies by the College in which the program resides)
 - UHD will accept a minimum of 12 hours of transfer Honors credit; eligible for merit and need-based aid commensurate with qualifications

Program Admission Requirements

(Associate of Applied Science (any) to Bachelor of Applied Arts & Sciences in Applied Administration)

Program Specific Requirements

- Student must have a cumulative 2.25 GPA.
- Student must complete any Associate of Applied Science degree at Lone Star College to major in Applied Administration at UHD.
- UHD will calculate the higher grade received on duplicate courses for GPA requirements.
- UHD will accept a "D" in courses.

- Student must complete any Associate of Applied Science degree at Lone Star College to major in Applied Administration at UHD.
- The BAAS-Applied Administration at UHD is a 120 credit hour degree program. It accepts 36 hours of the occupational/technical courses, regardless of the number of credit hours of occupational/technical courses required for completion of the AAS degree. This example shows the loss of 9 semester credit hours of occupational/technical courses.
