Notes/Comments:

(1) EDUC 1300 is required for First Time in College (FTIC) students only. If not FTIC, take SPCH 1311. Students who are FTIC are still required to complete SPCH 1311.

(2) Students must take Beginning I course and Beginning II course of the same language: ARAB, CHIN, FREN, GERM, ITAL, JAPN, SGNL, SPAN. Selection of an Intermediate Level course may also fulfill Language, Philosophy and Culture requirement (core 050) at LSC, allowing the student to select an additional elective course. Student should also consult with an advisor for language testing for credit if already fluent in a foreign language.

Transfer of Credit & Student Benefits

- Credits from LSC that are transferrable to UHD degree programs may be specified in any program-to-program articulation agreement.
- Reverse transfer
- LSC students will be allowed access to academic advising services at UHD
- LSC Honors students admitted to UHD will receive:
 - Acceptance to UHD Honors Program with a minimum GPA (GPA varies by the College in which the program resides)
 - UHD will accept a minimum of 12 hours of transfer Honors credit; eligible for merit and need-based aid commensurate with qualifications
