# Program Specific Information: Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice

• Student must complete a minimum of 30 upper level hours and minimum 24 upper level Criminal Justice hours at UHD with a minimum of 36 upper level hours overall.

## Program Admissions Requirements:

- Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.
- UHD will calculate the higher grade received if a course is taken more than once for GPA requirements.
- UHD will accept a "D" in 1000/2000 level courses.

### **Transfer of Credit & Student Benefits:**

- Credits from LSC that are transferrable to UHD degree programs may be specified in any program-to-program articulation agreement.
- Reverse transfer
- · LSC students will be allowed access to academic advising services at UHD
- LSC Honors students admitted to UHD will receive:
  - Acceptance to UHD Honors Program with a minimum GPA (GPA varies by the College in which the program resides)
  - UHD will accept a minimum of 12 hours of transfer Honors credit; eligible for merit and need-based aid commensurate with gualifications
