Dr. Jonathan Chism, Assistant Professor of African American Studies

Department of History, Humanities & Languages:

Dr. Chism's work, *African American Religion: An Introduction,* is under contract with Routledge Press. The book will offer an up-to-date survey of African American religious history that draws on secondary literature and select primary sources in the field. His work aligns with UHD's commitment to diversity and inclusion and will enhance appreciate of the richness and diversity of the African American experience and help scholar and students understand the long and ongoing Black struggle for freedom and justice in America. Dr. Chism also plans to propose a new course in African American Religious History.

Dr. Laura Cesarco Eglin, Assistant Professor of English Department of English:

Dr. Cesarco Eglin plans to explore through poetry what it means to be multicultural and multilingual. The poetry collection, whose working title is "Refractions, Reflections, Translations: Migrating Tongues," unfolds language into what expresses this rhizomatic reality of interconnections and coexistence of cultures and languages, and, concomitantly, language as the object of wonder and fascination, that which is being examined. Language as communication, language as resistance, language as thought, language as navigation, language as object and subject. This project is relevant to UHD as a Hispanic and Minority Serving Institution, and its students, most of whom are from a multicultural background and are bilingual.

Dr. Katharine Jager, Professor of English Department of English:

Dr. Jager's book manuscript revision of Making Books, Making the Self with collaborator Medieval will be submitted to Institute her Publications/ARC Humanities Press's interdisciplinary "global history, culture and heritage" series and draws directly from UHD's teaching pedagogy. The project is an inquiry into how North American students with limited archival access might interrogate, theorize and remediate digitized pre-modern manuscripts. Dr. Jager positions her work as an intervention into medieval studies, manuscript studies, the history of the book, theories of the archive, multimodality, and critical pedagogy.

Dr. Peter Li, Associate Professor of Political Science

Department of Social Sciences:

Dr. Li's work focuses scholarly attention on the conversation ramifications of inter-state diplomacy involving nonhuman animals and brings a new question (diplomacy and conservation) to the current studies of China's soft power. His project has significance to the international relations discipline, the Department of Social Sciences, CHSS, and the University by enhancing POL 3317 Animal Rights & Politics, which he has taught since 2016. The project also adds value to towards a minor program focused on animal welfare.

Dr. Claude Rubinson, Associate Professor of Sociology Department of Social Sciences:

Building upon his existing work and software development for conductive Qualitative Comparative Analysis (QCA), Dr. Rubinson will endeavor to rewrite his Kirq software that will improve performance, better support QCA practice, and incorporate modern procedures, metrics and protocols that are currently missing. His work also includes the draft of a monograph to serve as a manual for the software. The primary significance of this project lies in its benefits to the international community of QCA researchers, offering them a free, user-friendly and powerful tool for conducting QCA.
