## Resolution on Searches Passed by University Faculties Executive Council, University of Houston System February 8, 2008

## Whereas:

- 1. The academic officers of a university play a key role in ensuring the quality and well-being of the institution by making decisions that directly affect research, teaching, and promotion and tenure, and
- 2. Faculty are key stakeholders in these areas,

The members of UFEC and the faculty senates of the UH system institutions resolve that:

- 1. Academic positions at the level of dean or higher should be filled through national searches,
- 2. Faculty representatives should play a strong leadership role and be well/broadly-represented at every stage of the search process, and
- 3. Faculty input should be given significant weight in the final decision.
