Upcoming Events

In this time of transition, we must remind ourselves that it is the faculty body that provides the continuity of an institution; that role demands vision and vigilance from faculty at all levels to ensure the health and growth of UHD.

President Search

Four finalists have been announced. At this stage of the process, feedback from the university community is critical. Each candidate will meet with various groups on campus, including an open forum with faculty and staff -3:15-4:15 pm on the second day of each visit. If you attend, you will be invited to complete eval forms for the committee. In addition, please share any questions/ideas/concerns with committee members about the candidates and about what strengths are most important in a new President.

Name Selection

As you know, Chairman Wilson met with the Faculty Senate as well as a student group on April 21 to discuss name selection. He indicated a strong interest in moving forward with a process that will include constituent input and assistance from a marketing firm before the Board makes a final decision (no time frame given). Dr. Castillo has confirmed that we have issued an RFP for a marketing/branding firm, apparently with initial focus on generating a list of names for consideration. Dr. Castillo has also has suggested that he would like to put together a representative group (students, faculty, staff, alums) to offer guidance during the process. The specific charges of the committee and the timeline for activity have not yet been identified, but it is possible appointments will occur in the coming weeks.
