



#### Adopted/Published New Bylaw:

7.3 University Committees

The UHD Staff Council shall be responsible for nominating and/or making recommendations of staff members to serve on university-wide committees as outlined in PS 01.A.01, PS 01.A.03, and other university policies that form committees with staff representation. When university policy does not outline procedures for staff nominations, the Staff Council President, in consultation with the policy's responsible party and/or designee, and with majority vote for approval from the Executive Board, will make the nomination of staff member(s) to university-wide committees when filling committee appointments and/or vacancies including, but not limited to, new appointments, expired appointments, or resignations.

The UHD Staff Council Membership Board, a crucial part of our UHD community, is composed of elected UHD Staff members who represent the staff and are elected by their peers annually. The board is comprised of the Staff Council President, Staff Council President-Elect, Staff Council Secretary, Staff Council Treasurer, Staff Council Communication Officer, and Division Ambassadors.

The Annual Staff Council (SC) Election process is managed by the Staff Council Elections Committee (SCEC) in partnership with Human Resources (HR) and the Staff Council Executive Board (SCEB). Any staff member who accepts a nomination for an elected SC position is automatically removed from assisting with the election process to ensure the integrity of the elections.

#### **Executive Member Benefits**

#### **Nomination Process**

All benefits-eligible Staff Council members in good standing and with a minimum of 1-year tenure at UHD, except administrative staff (assistant and associate deans, deans, executive directors, assistant and associate vice presidents, vice presidents, and the University President), are eligible for Executive Board nomination. Staff may be eligible to run for officer and ambassador positions concurrently but can only hold one office.


All nominations are reviewed by HR to ensure eligibility. Qualified nominees will be placed on the ballot for the election process, which is handled by the Staff Council Membership Board and Elections Committee.

To begin the nomination process, nominators must complete the Staff Council Membership Board Nomination Form

 On the first Monday of April through the third Monday of April, a "Call for Nominations" is sent to all UHD staff via email by current SC President or Communications Officer.

Bylaw Review (Spring 2025)



New Proposed Bylaw Received:

8. Staff Climate Survey (Introduce this new bylaw)

The Staff Climate Survey shall assess staff satisfaction, engagement, workplace culture, and other relevant factors that contribute to the overall staff experience. UHD Staff Council shall ensure the survey is designed to capture actionable data and feedback in an anonymous, inclusive, and equitable manner. Development of the survey shall be a collaborative effort with Human Resources and Institutional Effectiveness. Results of the survey shall be shared with University leadership and staff, and UHD Staff Council shall make recommendations for addressing key findings and areas for improvement. UHD Staff Council will also facilitate follow-up communication regarding the actions taken in response to the survey results.

#### **Proposed Amendment to Section 4: Duties and Responsibilities**

Add the following line as a responsibility of Staff Council:

- Administering the Staff Climate Survey in the fall of every odd-numbered year.

Follow-up to Staff Council Comments/Suggestions/Questions:

(1) Is it being taken into consideration that all staff will be returning to campus full-time as of June 1st? Meaning there will be an increase of staff on campus. (In reference to availability of dining services as we navigate a transition to a new vendor)

#### **Response:**

Regarding summer dining operations and staff returning to campus June 1st, dining hours and food offerings will be adjusted based on foot traffic and sale volume. With 85% of summer courses are online, summer dining service will be limited.



Follow-up to Staff Council Comments/Suggestions/Questions:

(2) Besides food and the university being affected what's the deal with raises you keep denying? When do we see that?

For the past four years faculty and staff have received merit or market-based salary increases. The following are the fiscal years, and the salary pool percentages received:

- FY2025 = 1.5% merit salary increase pool
- FY2024 = 2% merit salary increase pool
- *Fy*2023 = 1.5% *merit salary increase pool*
- FY2022 = 5% merit pool for market base and comp. study salary adjustments

The university's budget development committee (PBDC) is currently working on the FY2026 budget recommendations which includes merit salary increase recommendations. The FY2026 budget will be finalized in July after the 89th legislative session has concluded. Communications on the budget and merit will be distributed when PBDC's recommendations are approved.


