Dear Student,

Return of Title IV (R2T4) is required when a student receives title IV financial aid and do not complete first 60 % point of the term, drops out, fails to earn a passing grade or is expelled from the university. Since funds are awarded based on a student attending the entire term, UHD Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid (OSFA) must recalculate a student's award based on the actual number of days the student attended.

Our office was notified that your grades for SUMMER 2025 were failing, which is an indication that you did not complete the courses attempted. **Grades of F, I, and U are considered failing grades.** Based on the Last Date of Attendance reported by your instructor, you did not complete your courses and therefore received failing grades.

You are not eligible for the financial aid you received for this semester because you have received failing grades in all your courses attempted. The **\$Amount** of your **\$\$Amount** Federal Stafford Loan has been returned to the Department of Education. You must return the **\$Amount** to the university as soon as possible.

If you have earned the failing grade or received a grade change and can show proof that you completed at least one of the courses, please contact our office within **15** <u>days</u> of this letter for a possible reversal of this decision.
