

AI-Transparent Exit Ticket

Purpose: This exit ticket helps you show what you learned, how you used AI, and how well your final work meets the course outcomes. You are not graded on whether or not you used AI. You are graded on your knowledge, judgment, and accomplishment of the learning outcomes.

Step 1: AI Tool Used

List the generative AI tool(s) you used for this task. Examples: ChatGPT, Copilot, Claude, Gemini. If you did not use AI, write “No AI Used.”

Step 2: Prompt(s) Used

Copy and paste the most helpful prompt you used to generate or revise your work. (You do not need to include every prompt—just the one that mattered most.)

Step 3: Self-Evaluation Using the Rubric

Study the assignment rubric. Then evaluate your own work using the same criteria your instructor will use. Use a numbered list that matches the rubric criteria.

Step 4: Brief Learning Reflection

In 4–5 sentences, reflect on your learning using the outcomes and your self-evaluation. You may want to address:

- What you understand better after this assignment.
- One area where the rubric helped you adjust or revise your work.
- One thing you would improve if you had more time.
- The methods you used to verify AI-outputs if you utilized them.

Step 5: Final AI-Transparent Submission

Submit your final work below or as an attached file.

- Keep your submission concise.
 - Make sure it clearly accomplishes the learning outcomes.
 - You are responsible for accuracy, clarity, and alignment with course concepts.
