UH-DOWNTOWN INTRAMURAL BASKETBALL 3-POINT CONTEST RULES

The intramural sports program is governed by the UHD Sports & Fitness Intramural Sports Handbook. It is too comprehensive to include here but participants are expected to familiarize themselves with it and adhere to its contents.

ELIGIBILTY

UHD intramural basketball 3-point contest is open to UHD students, faculty, staff, and other UHD Sports & Fitness members. Each individual is required to turn his/her valid UHD ID before each game to the scorekeeper. An ID must also have a Sports & Fitness sticker indicating he/she has completed a release form. The forms are available at each entrance of the Student Life Center.

GAME REGULATIONS

UHD intramural 3 point shooting will be conducted under the rules of the NFHS.

PLAYING AREA

There will be 5 spots marked on the floor beyond the 3-point line.

OBJECTIVE

Players will have 25 attempts to make as many 3-point baskets from 5 different spots beyond the 3-point line within one minute. After 5 attempts from one spot, the player will rotate to the next spot.

LENGTH OF THE GAME

There are two rounds, the qualifying round and final round.

- Participants will be given one minute in the qualifying round. The top five scorers will advance to the final round.
- Final round qualifiers will be given one minute in the final round. The winner will be determined by the sum of the qualifying and final round scores. Any tie breakers after the total scores will be determined by an additional minute.
