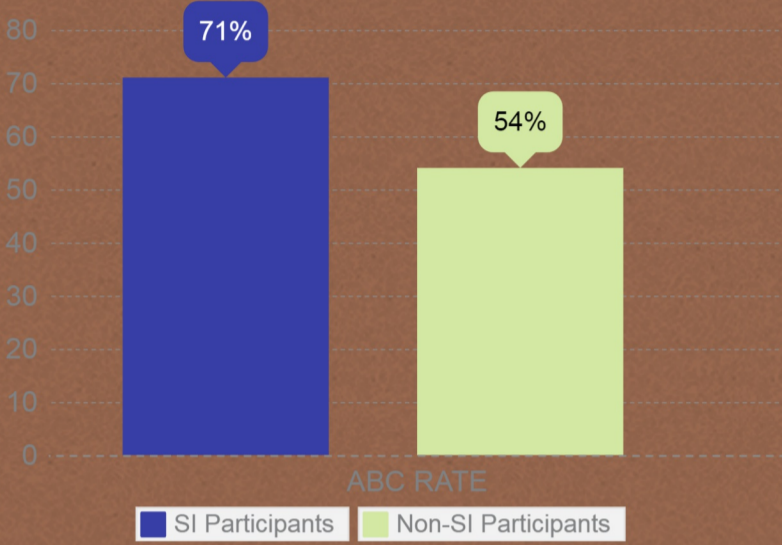


# IMPACT OF SI ON GRADES FALL 2015

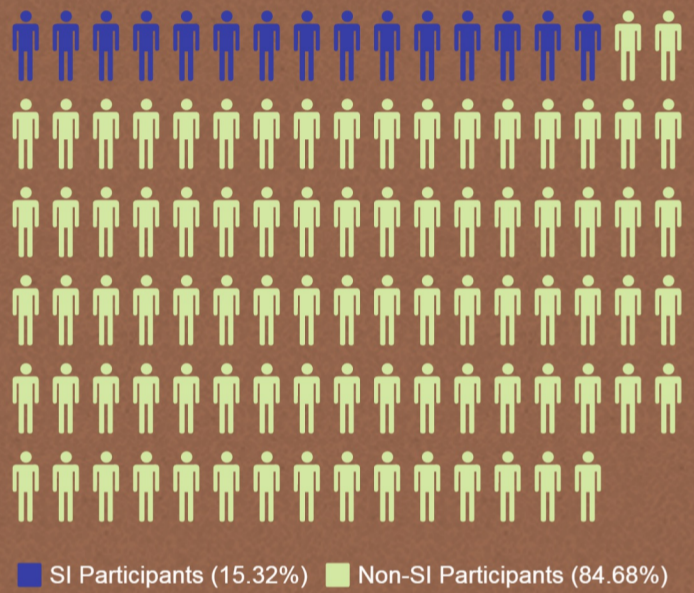
## OVERVIEW



In Fall 2015, the University of Houston-Downtown SI Program offered over 1,900 sessions with an average of 2 student attending per session.

Across all sections, 61% of students who attended SI came to sessions more than once.

## Withdrawals



The data above represents the percentage of withdrawals per group divided by the total number of students in SI sections who withdrew.

- 38%** Overall attendance to SI sessions
- 3004** Number of contact hours
- 0.5** GPA difference between SI participants and non-participants

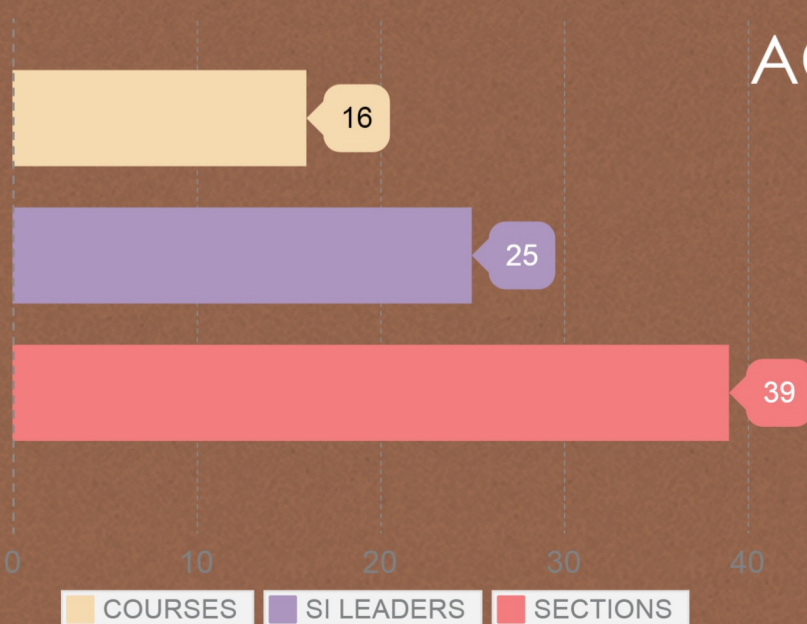
